Fish Meal and Fish Oil Raw Materials

EWOS prioritises the use of feed ingredients that it judges to be sustainable, and the judgement is based upon the best available information. Fish meal and fish oil used in the fish feed come from fisheries regulated by national and international authorities according to scientific recommendations (ICES, IMARPE, Sernapesca etc), also including fish trimmings and by-catches from such fisheries. We support IFFO's Responsible Supply Certification Program and similar initiatives.


Marine raw materials for fish meal and fish oil purchased by EWOS AS and used in our production of compound fish feed for salmonids do not origin from IUU fisheries (Illegal, Unreported or Unregistered) or is classified as critically endangered or endangered in the UICN Red List.

Trimmings (from capelin, herring, whitefish – origin as above) contributes with a substantial part of the marine raw material.

Raw materials and suppliers are evaluated and approved prior to supply and raw materials are purchased on strict specifications. Supplies are followed by Certificates of analyses and follow-up according to risk based control plans. Fish meal and Oil from raw materials from areas such as the Baltic are cleaned from undesirables and analysed for PCDD/F according to EU regulation 225/2012.
